

First Century Church



Why are there so many churches?

With tens of thousands of different churches and denominations, with their opposing beliefs and practices in the world today, we are often left confused. Which church is the “right” church? Which church does God approve? Which church did Christ establish? In Acts 2, we read of the one true church that was established by Jesus Christ and sanctioned by God. Many religious groups have departed from the first century church, splintering into the various churches and denominations we see today. If we seek to be the one true church established by Jesus Christ in the first century, as described in Acts 2, we must rid ourselves of man-made creeds, doctrines and traditions, and become the first century church we read about in the New Testament.

Denominationalism Contradicts the Bible - Part 1

Denominationalism Teaches

The Bible Teaches

There are many bodies or churches	→ One Body/Church (1 Corinthians 12:20)
Churches founded by men	→ Church Founded by Christ (Matthew 16:18)
Human heads of the church	→ Christ is the Head (Ephesians 1:22-23)
Human Creeds	→ Bible is the only guide (2 Timothy 3:6-17)
Wear human names	→ Glorify God as a Christian (1 Peter 4:16)
Follows men	→ Condemns following men (1 Cor. 1:10-13)
Multiplicity of churches	→ One Church (Romans 16:16)
Membership not essential	→ Saved are added to the church (Acts 2:47)
Preaches many gospels	→ Only one gospel (Galatians 1:8-9)

Denominationalism Contradicts the Bible - Part 2

Denominationalism Teaches

The Bible Teaches

Rewrites creeds from time to time	→ God's Word never changes (Matthew 24:35)
Teaches many faiths	→ "One faith" (Ephesians 4:5)
Teaches many baptisms	→ "One baptism" (Ephesians 4:5)
Teaches that people join churches	→ The Lord adds the saved to the church (Acts 2:47)
Claim to be abiding branches of the Church	→ Branches are individuals, not churches (John 15:1-6)
Walk by different rules	→ Walk by the same rule (Philippians 3:16)
Thanks God for many churches	→ Jesus prayed for oneness (John 17:20-21)
Claim doctrine is inconsequential	→ Doctrine is important (1 Timothy 4:16)


